Thank you for providing us with the opportunity to respond to the Shepparton South East PSP public consultation.

The department supports the location designated in the PSP for State Government Health Facility and notes that the requirements and guidelines included in the PSP are consistent with previous advice provided on general site parameters. This designation ensures that the department can access future land sites to support the delivery of our health infrastructure program and to provide the best outcomes for the community of Shepparton.

The department notes the inclusion of Guideline G23 and is comfortable that the land identified as a proposed State Government Health Facility may be used for an alternative purpose until such time the department requires the land. However, the department requests that any mentions of potential uses, such as the mentioned local pop-up park, be removed from the wording of the guideline as to not create false expectations in the community about the long-term use of the land.
