Thanks for providing the Department of Health and the Victorian Health Building Authority (VHBA) with the opportunity to comment on the public consultation documents for the Casey Fields South (Employment) and Devon Meadows Precinct Structure Plan (PSP).

The department and VHBA support the proposal for a Health facility to be located in the Mixed Use area on the Devon Meadows Precinct.

The department has identified that the south-east growth corridor may require additional acute and subacute health services to meet expectations of higher-than-average complex health care needs in the region. This provision would help meet government objectives to deliver accessible community and health services in the south-east growth corridor.

The department and VHBA support the provision of an emergency services facility to be located in the Casey Fields South Precinct, fronting the South Gippsland Highway near IN-05.

This is in line with analysis from Ambulance Victoria, which has noted that an ambulance branch will be required to service the wider area and ensure optimum response times can be met.
