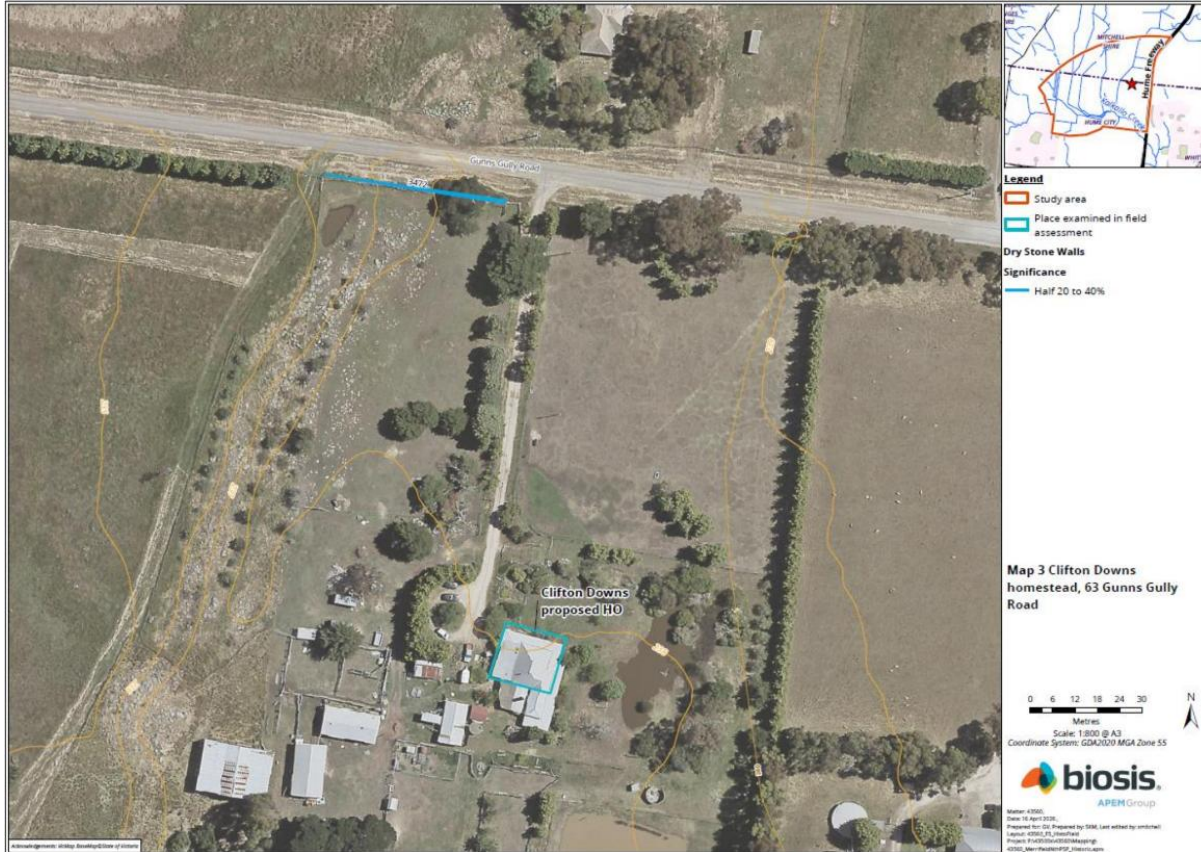

What is significant?

Clifton Downs is a small early twentieth century timber farmhouse at 63 Gunns Gully Road, Mickleham.

How is it significant?

Clifton Downs is a small early twentieth century timber farmhouse at 63 Gunns Gully Road, Mickleham.

Why is it significant?

Clifton Downs is of historical significance as representative of early twentieth century intensification of agriculture in the Donnybrook-Mickleham district when cultivation of crops and diversified farming led to smaller farms established from the former pastoral estates. It is associated with several prominent farmers including John Anderson and the Laffan brothers.
